Summary of Major Contributions (at the time of nomination)

At the time of nomination, Brenton Eckert's major contributions included the following:

- The first Queensland-based President of ANZSRS, from 2001 to 2002;
- He had previously served as a Queensland Board member from 1991-1994, then 1999-2000;
- He was consistently a keen supporter of, and significant contributor to, ANZSRS annual scientific meetings, including:
 - Involvement in the local organising committees for the 1994, 2001, and 2010 ASMs (the latter as LOC Chair);
 - A contributor to at least 25 presentation at 18 ASMs since 1984, including 12 as presenter and 13 as co-author, and also as an invited speaker;
- Locally (i.e. within Queensland), Brenton has always been a great supporter and mentor of young scientists, especially encouraging interest and participation in research, encouraging involvement in ANZSRS activities at all levels, and advocating pursuit of professional development opportunities wherever they appear.
