Summary of Major Contributions (at the time of nomination)

At the time of nomination, Judy Roget's major contributions to the Society included the following:

- Judy was a founding member of the Society and was actively involved in the drafting of the original constitution. Her professionalism and attention to detail around all aspects of the Society's activities and compliance to appropriate procedures stood the Society in good stead during its infancy.
- Judy was a foundation Board member of the then ASRT and President of the Society for a period of four years. During this time Judy actively recruited many of today's more prominent members, ensured transparency of the Society finances and developed the ASMs.
- Perhaps her greatest stamp on the shape of today's Society was her staunch advocacy for the independence of the ANZSRS from other medical societies and for a proud organisation, representing a profession with specialised skills, which stood shoulder to shoulder with other organisations.
