Summary of Major Contributions (at the time of nomination)

At the time of nomination, Paul Guy's major contributions included the following:

- Paul Guy was involved with the running of 10 Annual Scientific Meetings. In particular, he organised the trade support for the Annual Scientific Meetings between 1990 and 2000 which increased the trade support very substantially. Paul's endeavours and his impressive management skills resulted in the accumulation of Society funds. This initiative put the Society's finances on a sound footing and had allowed many other Society activities to be maintained and initiated, such as the ANZSRS Travel Grants and Education scholarships.
- Paul served on the Executive as President of the Society (1997 1999). During his Presidency he resurrected and supported the Society's newsletter, Mouthpiece, a regular publication which was valued and enjoyed by the membership.
- Paul also represented ANZSRS on the TSANZ Professional Standards Subcommittee from 2000 2002.
