Summary of Major Contributions (at time of nomination)

At the time of nomination, Peter Rochford's major contributions included the following:

- Sub-Editor, Volume: 1983-1987 – During the 1980's the ANZSRS published a peer-review journal showcasing the work of its members and outside contributors. Peter was one of the sub-editors for this journal.
- Board Member: 1985-86, 1995-96, 1999-2000 – Over these 3 separate stints Peter was a part of the ANZSRS Board helping to guide and develop the society.
- Standards Committee member: 1991-94 – This committee reviewed standards which were used across the society.
- ASM Local organising committee: 1991, 1996, 1999, 2000, 2006 – Peter has been a member of 5 ASM organising committees.
- Chairman, CRFS review committee: 2005-2008 – Peter chaired the CRFS review committee over these 4 years, which saw an extensive re-write of much of the CRFS exam
- CRFS co-ordinator: 2007-2019 – Peter was the co-ordinator for the CRFS exam for 12 years. This role included not only the administration of the exam, but also co-ordinating CRFS workshops at annual scientific meetings.

During his time as CRFS co-ordinator Peter organised the CRFS workshops at the ANZSRS Annual Scientific Meeting. Peter was one of the presenters at these workshops during most of these years.

Outside of these office-bearing positions, Peter has also made significant contributions to the ANZSRS in terms of research and education. He has presented his own research on many occasions and been a co-author on numerous presentations at ANZSRS ASMs. He has also been an invited speaker at the ANZSRS ASM on numerous occasions over the years. In addition to all of this, Peter has been on numerous judging panels and abstract review committees for the ANZSRS.
